ENSURING THE FUTURE OF THE GAME

Through our support of Junior Golf programs we promote the grass roots efforts necessary to develop golf participation. In addition to providing FREE Handicap Services to all Junior members, our initiatives include Oregon Junior Golf Fund, Inc., that conducts a comprehensive schedule of more than 40 Junior Golf competitions throughout the state each summer and selects (and provides financial assistance) to the state's top juniors each year to compete in national and international team competitions. It also includes the Erling Jacobsen Developmental Tour, support for USGA/LPGA Girls Golf, U.S. Kids Golf, support for OSAA High School Golf Championships as well as the First Tee program that teaches both life skills and golf.
