



2011 POINT SCHEDULE

The OGA Tour Points System is used to determine who will earn an invitation to participate in the OGA Tour Championship to be held Saturday, October 22, 2011 at Bandon Dunes Golf Resort.

All OGA Members are eligible to earn points toward qualification. Eligible events include all Individual, Partner and Senior Series events.

At the conclusion of each eligible event, points will be earned based on the value of prizes awarded for either a gross or net finish. Not included in the points are prizes won in closest to the hole, straight drive, long putt.

Should an individual or team be scheduled to receive a prize in both the gross and net division they will only be awarded prizes and points in the division where the value of the prize is the highest.

In addition, all players who start an event will be awarded one participation point regardless of finish position.

Eligibility: To receive points, a competitor must be an active member of an OGA Member Club at the time of the competition. In addition, to compete for any net prizes or points, the competitor must also have an active USGA Handicap Index at the time of the competition.

Handicap Adjustments: At any time prior to the close of competition, the Committee may modify a player's handicap. In addition, if necessary the OGA will adjust handicaps according to Section 3-5 of the USGA Handicap System.

Ties: In the event that players are tied for the final spot into the Tour Championship or any other contest promoted by the OGA, the tie will be broken in the following order. One, the player with the most events played to date in the Series the players are tied will be determined the winner. If the players are still tied, the player with the most OGA Tour events to date will be determined the winner, regardless of Series. If the players are still tied, the winner will be determined by lot.

Partner Series Events: Both competitors will receive full points. For example if you and your partner win a prize valued at \$100 (of which you split), you will both be awarded 100 points. You are welcome to switch partners throughout the season as the points you earn at each event are not awarded to the "team" but to each individual on the team.
