**Lunch:**

A lunch will be available in the white tent just south of the Clubhouse and Pro Shop. Depending upon the weather, either a deli buffet or BBQ will be available to all participants.

**Range Balls:**

Warm up range balls will be available on the tee at the driving range for all players.

**Caddies:**

Chambers Bay has a large number of caddies for hire if you wish. The basic fee for a caddy is \$45. **Dress Code:**

**Shoes-All participants**

**Golf shoes with metal spikes or the like are not allowed at Chamber Bay GC**

**Female Dress Code:** The WSGA expects all participants to wear suitable attire on the host club property throughout the duration of the Casual Golf Day. Suitable attire does not include cutoffs, short shorts, tank tops, halters, jeans or denim of any kind or color, tee shirts, bare midriff, spandex, sweat pants or unkempt clothing of any kind. Tailored blouses or golf shirts (if a shirt is sleeveless, it must have a collar) must be worn. Applicants must wear slacks, golf skirts or shorts. Skirts and shorts must not be shorter than 5 inches above the middle of the knee. Hats and visors must not be worn in the clubhouse. Shoes and socks must be worn at all times. Sandals of any kind are not allowed on the golf course at any time, even sandals with soft spikes. Failure to adhere to the dress code may result in removal from the course.

**Male Dress Code:** The WSGA expects all participants to wear suitable attire on the host club property throughout the duration of the Casual Golf Day. Suitable attire does not include cutoffs, short shorts, tank tops, jeans or denim of any kind or color, tee shirts, sweat pants or unkempt clothing of any kind. Clean and neat slacks, bermuda or walking shorts must be worn. Shorts must be no shorter than 5 inches above the middle of the knee. **Golf shirts with collars are mandatory.** Hats and visors must not be worn in the clubhouse. Shoes and socks must be worn at all times. Sandals of any kind are not allowed on the golf course at any time (including practice areas), even sandals with soft spikes. Failure to adhere to the dress code may result in removal from the course.
