Cancellations

You may cancel any time before the closing deadline and receive a refund of the entry fee minus a \$20 administrative fee. After the closing deadline all refunds are at the sole discretion of the host course.

Dress Code, Regulations and Policies

All participants must abide by the Rules and Policies of the host club, Tualatin Country Club, including the dress code and cell phone policy below:

DRESS CODE

Failure to adhere to the dress code may result in denial of the use of the golf facilities.

No jeans or denim pants allowed
All sport hats must be worn bill-forward
No sport hats or visors upstairs in the clubhouse

All shorts must be lower than mid thigh
No fleece or cotton sweat outfits
No cut-off shorts

Men:

Shirts must have a collar.
Shirts must be tucked in

Women:

No halter-top, tube-top, or mid-riff tops.
Any shoulder strap must be at least 2".

CELL PHONE POLICY

Cell phones and pagers must be off or in 'silent' mode on the golf course, and all cell phone use is prohibited inside the clubhouse.
