DRESS CODE: Business casual or traditional golf attire is requested. At minimum, all dress must be kept and clean. On-Course Rules Clinics will be taught primarily outside and you should be prepared to spend most of your day outdoors and are expected to dress accordingly.

REGISTRATION FEE/ELIGIBILITY: Juniors must not have reached their 18th birthday by the first day of the workshop. Without prior approval from the OGA, a junior must be accompanied by a paid parent or guardian throughout the workshop. OGA Volunteers include the following: TAG Team, Course Raters, OGA Directors, OGA Executive Committee & OGA Handicap Chairs. OGA Members must be an active member of an OGA Member Club and have an active USGA handicap index with that club. PGA/LPGA Members must be active members of either the PGA of America or the LPGA. PNWPGA section members are eligible to receive 20 MSRs at workshops and 5 MSRs at clinics. Standard Rate includes all others attendees.

TRANSFERS: In the event that you are unable to attend an event you have registered for and notify the OGA prior to the registration deadline, you may transfer your entry to another OGA Rules Education event on a space available basis. All transfers will be charged a \$10 administrative fee.

WITHDRAWALS: If you decide to withdraw you may do so on the OGA website or by notifying the OGA. Your registration fee will be refunded minus an administrative fee according to the following schedule: 3 weeks prior to the event: (\$10 clinics, \$20 workshops); 1 week prior to the event: (\$15 clinics, \$60 workshops); If you withdraw for any reason within 1 week of the event your entire registration fee will be forfeited.

METHOD OF ENTRY: The OGA accepts walk-in, phone, mail, fax and online entries. Note that walk-in, phone and mailed entries must be received during normal business hours at the OGA office (Entries by mail are considered received when they arrive at the OGA office not by the postmark date). OGA Administrative Office Hours are Mon-Fri, 8am - 5pm. Entries found under the office door, via phone message or by mail after normal business hours will not be processed until the following business day.
